CIVIL WAR ARTILLERY PROJECTILES AND ACCESSORIES EXHIBIT AT LINCOLN PARISH LIBRARY

Secretary of State Jay Dardenne and the staff of the Louisiana Military Museum are announcing the opening of a Civil War artillery projectiles and accessories exhibit at the Lincoln Parish Library. The exhibit is free and will be on display through April 13.

The exhibit contains about 20 projectiles from the Civil War. Guests can view a scale replica of a Civil War cannon and limber, a two-wheeled cart used for holding an ammunition chest, assorted fuses and accessories connected with Civil War artillery such as swords. Pictures of artillery in use are also on display.

The Louisiana Military Museum features a unique collection of military memorabilia spanning eight wars over 150 years. Weapons, from swords and muskets to heavy machine guns, are part of the expansive collection. Artillery pieces are also displayed on the grounds.
