CONGRESSIONAL EXHIBIT AT LOUISIANA'S OLD STATE CAPITOL

Secretary of State Jay Dardenne is announcing the "Louisianians on the Hill: A Congressional Exhibit" opening on Tuesday, April 15 at 3 p.m. at Louisiana's Old State Capitol. Secretary Dardenne invited all former congressional members to the opening and at present Patrick Caffery, Henson Moore, John Rarick and Dave Treen will join him in dedicating the exhibit. All former congressional members in attendance will be recognized by the Legislature prior to the opening.

The exhibit showcases a variety of memorabilia including articles of clothing, bumper stickers, buttons, campaign posters, photographs and plaques. The display features photographs of former Congressman Dave Treen golfing with President Gerald Ford; photographs and plaques from former Senator Elaine Edwards and former Congressman Henson Moore; and campaign materials from former Congressman John Rarick.

The exhibit will be on display at Louisiana's Old State Capitol at 100 North Blvd. in Baton Rouge through the end of the year. The public is invited to view the exhibit during regular museum hours: Tuesday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Sunday, noon to 4 p.m.; open Mondays for special tours. Admission is free and the building is wheelchair accessible.
