SECRETARY OF STATE DARDENNE ANNOUNCES MUSEUM GROUNDBREAKING

Secretary of State Jay Dardenne is announcing the Eddie G. Robinson Museum groundbreaking ceremony will take place at 2 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 20. Secretary Dardenne invites the public to attend the event at the Grambling State University Women's Gym across from the Grambling Post Office. Community leaders and members of the Robinson family will unveil the museum plans at the event.

Act 1368 of the 1999 Legislative Session recognized that it was appropriate to establish a museum at Grambling State University to honor the legendary football coach Eddie G. Robinson. Robinson coached football at Grambling from 1941 to 1997, and he was named NCAA Division I football's all-time winningest coach after winning 408 games. He saw more than 80 percent of his 4,000 athletes graduate and more than 200 of them play in the NFL.
